He was also influenced by John Denver and James Taylor as well as Peter, Paul and Mary. Will has been recognized as a significant songwriter and has had four of his songs featured in the Lazarus Filmworks production of "God Where Are You" He is a frequent featured performer in Nashville Tennessee. **Joanie Brown** (Mary Travers) is a performer at heart. She recalls singing and dancing as far back as she can remember; however, pursuits in a career in engineering and then later in natural medicine, acupuncture and teaching kept Brown from the stage until joining the tribute group in 2011. Musically, Brown has performed in Ribbon of Life - Golden Rainbow production show, and more recently in a showcase variety show called Unstoppable with Guinness Book of World Record's fastest juggler, Nino Frediani. Joanie's compassionate nature resonates to the music of Peter, Paul and Mary with their uncompromising message of reform, freedom, justice and love. Gordon is a Cantor with over 45 years of performing as a vocal artist, guitarist and violinist. His love and passion for the music and its message is evident as he interacts with audiences sharing stories of struggle, love and perseverance. His influences include Joan Baez, Pete Seeger, The Weavers, Loree Wyatt and Tom Paxton. **Will Kruger** (Paul “Noel” Stookey) is an accomplished entertainer, guitarist, singer and songwriter. For 30 years he has been performing, writing and recording original music with his primary love in folk music. His detail to the history and message of the 60's is unmistakable during his performance. His influences include James Taylor, John Denver and of course, Peter, Paul and Mary.
